



The Department of English and American Studies is seeking to appoint a:

Lecturer with special duties in English “Sprachpraxis” (language courses)

This is a full-time permanent position.

You will be required to:

- teach 16 weekly 45-minute periods during term-time over the entire range of English-language courses (grammar, German-English translation, oral and written communication) with particular reference to teacher-training courses for German secondary schools
- form part of a team developing and putting into place curricula and teaching materials
- share administrative duties whenever necessary

Successful applicants will have:

- completed a higher education degree (MA or equivalent) or PhD in an appropriate field of English or American studies (literature/culture, linguistics, translation or education in English, TEFL, TESOL or equivalent)
- provided evidence of expertise and experience in teaching English as a foreign language at university level
- native-speaker competence in English and excellent knowledge of written and spoken German
- resilience, teamwork skills and reliability

They should preferably also have:

- experience with e-learning and e-learning tools/platforms (e.g. Moodle)
- recognized additional teaching qualifications (e.g. university teaching, TESOL, CELTA, DELTA certificates or equivalent)

We particularly welcome applications from women, who will receive preferential consideration given similar aptitude, qualifications and experience, as required under state equal opportunities legislation, except in the case of compelling reasons for choosing another applicant.
