

Guide for Editors of Selected Papers - Proceedings in *Anglistik: International Journal of English Studies*

PLANNING

- The selected papers issue comprises the peer-reviewed articles based on papers delivered at the annual conference, each of about 6,000-8,000 words, as well as a short introduction by the editor(s)/local organizers and brief introductions (of around 2,000 words) to the various panels by the panel organizers. Please inform the editorial office in good time about the probable number and length of the selected papers.
- The deadline for submission of edited manuscripts is 1 April.
- Please provide the individual contributors with a copy of the style sheet.
- If some of the authors wish to include images, they are required to obtain permission to reproduce these from the copyright holder. Please note that, as an academic journal, we are not able to pay any fees for this. Copyright holders usually ask for the following details before they grant permission to reprint images: *Anglistik: International Journal of English Studies* (ISSN 0947-0034) is edited by Heinz Antor (University of Cologne) and Julia Hoydis (University of Cologne) on behalf of the German Association of University Professors of English. *Anglistik* is an electronic open-access journal published three times a year (Spring, Summer, Winter). We publish articles and book reviews in various fields of Cultural Studies, English Literature, Linguistics and Philosophy. Readership: academics in the field of English Studies. Articles are registered by all major bibliographies (e.g. PMLA, IBZ, Library of Congress, etc.). EDITING THE MANUSCRIPTS

- Apart from working on the argument/content of the articles, editors are asked to ensure that the contributors follow the style sheet and use precise academic language.
- Contributions with grave linguistic shortcomings must be proof-read by a suitably qualified native speaker of English.
- All quotations have to be referenced using in-text citations in brackets (author-date style; cf. style sheet). Please check that in-text citations match the respective entry in the Works Cited and that the latter lists all of the literature referred to in the article.
Editors are encouraged to send an edited sample article to the editorial office, whose staff will be happy to provide feedback and a template for editing further articles.

MANUSCRIPT SUBMISSION

- Please submit all articles as word-files. You are welcome to send us individual articles before the deadline once you have finished editing them.
- By the deadline all manuscripts including the introduction, a list of contributors (name, affiliation, departmental address, email-address), and a document stating the order in which you would like to see the contributions published should be sent to redaktion-anglistik@uni-koeln.de.
