The **Department of English and American Studies** at the University of Salzburg is seeking to appoint a research assistant (**post-doc**) with responsibilities in research and teaching acc. to the University Act and (Austrian) Employees Act. The successful applicant will receive a gross monthly salary of € 3.626,60 (14 x a year) according to §26 of the wage agreement of the universities.

- **Duration of employment:** 6 years
- **Hours:** 40 (full-time)
- **Working hours:** by arrangement
- **Responsibilities:** You will be given the opportunity to complete a *habilitation* (post-doctoral qualification) in the field of English/applied linguistics as part of the 6-year contract; upon completion of the *habilitation*, the contract will become a permanent one. Additionally, you will be expected to conduct your own academic research in the area(s) of English/applied linguistics, support existing research projects in these areas (conducting text/media linguistic research), teach classes (4 hours per week in the area of English linguistics) for the B.A., M.A. and the teacher's training program for the Department, supervise theses, support the editing of publications, and perform administrative tasks for the Chair of English/applied linguistics and the Department.
- **Employment requirements / qualifications:** completed Ph.D. in English/Applied Linguistics (or another linguistic field); published Ph.D. thesis (or an official commitment from a publisher); experience in teaching and conducting research in English/applied linguistics; relevant publications and conference talks; experience in obtaining third-party funding.
- **Desirable additional qualifications:** interest/experience in media linguistics and multimodality research; international experience; ties to the research community.
- **Desirable personality traits:** ability to cooperate and work in a team, reliability, thoroughness, enthusiasm and dedication.
